

Adults Daytime Programme

There is an Adult Hub located in and around the vicinity of the Clive Emson building. This is an area for Leaders and staff to unwind, relax and engage in programme.

Grab your mug and get your teas and coffees from the Urban Cafe. Every adult has a thermal mug as part of their package. You need to collect this from the Hubcamp HQ in the Urban Zone.

There are many programme and activity elements in these areas. The programme and training elements have been released via newsletters and there will be daily updates on noticeboards and screens around the Clive Emson building, on the event App and in the Adult Hub.

If you have booked training programmes these will have been released to you during the week beginning 21st July. Costs should have been paid. There may be some spaces for programme still to book. You will need to do this at the Training HQ.
