## DRONE USAGE

Due to microlight activity and increased aerial traffic around the festival, a NOTAM is in place covering the showground and surrounding area. As such, no drones may be flown over the festival site unless explicitly authorised by both the Festival Media Team and the NOTAM contact operator.

All approved drone flights must:

- Stay below 50 feet
- Remain within visual line of sight of the operator at all times
- Comply with Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) rules

Any unauthorised aerial activity over the showground will be reported and investigated in coordination with the NOTAM team and Jamcom
